**2. JURISDICTION;** Held under the National Sporting Code of the MCF and Beach Cross Standing Regulations of the MCF, These Supplementary Regulations and any further instructions that may be issued. **Club Restricted event.**

**3. ELIGIBILITY;** Open to members of All Terrain Events - ATE/ QRA riding Quad and Solo Machines.  
All riders must hold an MCF LICENCE issued by the MCF.

**Any other rider from within the EU including all Irish participants must obtain their own personal accident/repatriation insurance. This is NOT provided by organisers or the MCF and is the responsibility of the competitor.**

2012 BXUK ATE MCF British Beach Cross Championship points only awarded to members of ATE and MCF Licence Holders. Riders can join at any event and the 'event' membership will be deducted from fee.

Each round of the championship is an individual event and event points count for members and non members.

### FINAL INSTRUCTIONS AND EVENT DETAILS WILL BE PROVIDED BEFORE THE EVENT.

### 4. ENTRIES & FEE'S; PLEASE NOTE THE NUMBER OF RIDERS IS RESTRICTED – FULL WHEN FULL.

Entries must be made on the official entry form and sent with the correct fee for the event.

Due to the amount of available entries in all classes riders entering for both days have priority over one day only riders until 10<sup>th</sup> February.

**ENTRY CLOSING DATE;** 20<sup>th</sup> February for programme inclusion.

Entries sent after 20<sup>th</sup> February or on the day 'space permitting' will incur late entry fee of £10 Acceptance and passes will be sent by post within 7 days of receipt of completed entry with payment.

**5. LICENCE;** MCFederation Full Competition Licence. You can purchase an **MC Federation One Event Licence** for the fee is £10 with your entry.

**6. CANCELLATION;** Rider cancellations can only be accepted in writing up to **7 DAYS** before the event.

The promoters reserve the right to alter, abandon or postpone this meeting, or part of it, if circumstances make it necessary.

**7. COMPETITOR PARKING & OVERNIGHT CAMPING;** COMPETITORS PARKING AREA IS OPEN FROM 3pm FRIDAY 2<sup>nd</sup> MARCH. **Those who can only arrive Saturday morning this is no problem.**

Parking and Camping will be in the top Dreamlands Car Park off the A254 Belgrave Road. NB; Tarmac surface so pitching a tent needs external fixing.

**Competitors Vehicle passes** will be checked – one vehicle in the competitor's car park per competitor. Additional vehicles without official pass will be charged a fee of £10 for the weekend by the landowners.

**Park as guided using minimum space PLEASE.**

**NOISE;** Generators & external noise must be **OFF by 10.30pm** as this is a residential area, please keep ALL noise down.

**WARNING; Riding in the car park = PROHIBITED**

Non competing Pit/mini bikes etc are not allowed. Please do not spoil a good thing by riding round the car park or running machines up BEFORE 9.00am.

The only riding in this area should for the Policed convoy to the beach each morning and on the return later. When instructed to join convoy riding in 1<sup>st</sup> gear at idle speed. Times will be detailed in final instructions

**Helmets must be worn at any time machine is in motion.**

### 8. COMPETITOR WORK AREA/PITS;

The work area is on to the beach below the Sands café close to the start and track and central to the event so that riders, supporters and crews are close to the action.

The WORK AREA is a **NO SMOKING AREA.**

This is NOT a spectator area, only those mechanics (two per rider) OVER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS OF AGE and wearing an official wrist band are permitted in the work area.

During the event access between the work area and vehicle paddock with machines under power is NOT PERMITTED.

This can only be done when the road is closed by the Police and marshal led at the start and end of each day.

At all other times machines can NOT be removed from the work area.

If withdrawing from the event then clearance to remove the machine must be approved and signed off by the Pit Marshal. Once granted must be pushed without engine running.

The Competitors Car Park is a short distance from the 'Work Area' on the beach. Trolleys, wheelbarrows, carts etc. advisable to haul tools etc you might need during the event.

**Only authorised official vehicles can access the closed road.**

OTHER VEHICLES ARE **NOT** PERMITTED TO ACCESS THE CLOSED ROAD AS IT IS AGAINST THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE EVENT WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES, H & S AND EMERGENCY SERVICES. IT WOULD ALSO HINDER THE PROGRESS OF THE EVENT AND POTENTIALLY REDUCE THE EVENT PROGRAMME.

**FIRE EXTINGUISHERS;** All competitors must possess a 2kg (minimum) dry powder fire extinguisher available for immediate use and be with their equipment in the work area.

#### 9. TECHNICAL CONTROL;

This will take place in the competitors car park; Along with all machines which may be ridden in the event please present your helmet/s and presented together with your charged **2kg (minimum) Dry Powder FIRE EXTINGUISHER** at Technical control.

**TYRES;** The use of single span **SCOOP** or **PADDLE TYRES** are **NOT PERMITTED**.

Sand, snow etc tyres must have broken tread, not **exceeding 19.5mm** in depth.

**NUMBERS & NUMBER PLATES;** DISPLAY ONLY the number for the event on machine and race shirt.

Numbers to be displayed on front, sides plus rear for Quads. The numbers and background **MUST** be to MCF regulation size and clearly readable.

Quads rear 'fin' number is optional but helpful to organisers. **Clear numbers also helps reporters, photographers, commentator and the public identify YOU !**

**NOISE TESTING/ CONTROL;** Sound measurements will be made throughout event in accordance to MCF 94dBA.

**10, COURSE;** All parts of track sand with jumps and undulations. The track will be groomed on Saturday evening and when the Clerk of Course deems necessary.

**11. START; Union Jack Flag and or Elastic Start gate**– 15 seconds then 5 seconds board will be displayed and the Union Jack Flag RAISED ↑. Riders jumping the start will penalised.

**Maximum number of competitors;**  
Quads = 34 per race. Solo = 35 per race..

#### 12. FORMAT;

Points scored both days will determine the **2012 Monarch of Margate Beach Cross Champions**.

*The points system for the BXUK 2012 ATE MCF British Beach Cross Championship for registered riders works on an open bases no matter which class A or B a rider qualifies for each round.*

**13. Awards** to minimum of top 3 in each class. Plus Special Prizes and awards.

#### CLASSES/FORMAT/AWARDS;

Each class will have 3 programmed rides per class per day.

**14. EVENT SCHEDULE;** Confirmed format and times will be sent out with final instructions, passes etc;

#### Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> March –

From 3pm Competitors Paddock will be open. You can arrive through the night. 8pm 'Meet and Greet' event – venue and tickets will be sent with acceptance.

#### Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> March;

**7.30am – 09.30am.** Documentation and transponder issuing at race HQ near Sands Cafe opposite the Clock Tower above the work area on the beach.

**8am Technical Control** – will take place in the competitor's car park.

**9.25am** ALL competitors to assemble at the gates of the competitor's car park. **NO RIDING AROUND THE CAR PARKS.**

**9.40am** ALL competitors follow one behind the other in procession out of the competitors parking area as directed by the Police and event officials from the car park to the beach in to the work area via temporary road closure.

**MISS THIS TIME & YOU WILL HAVE TO PUSH YOUR MACHINE – QUAD OR SOLO TO THE WORK AREA.**

**09.50am** Rider's briefing in the Work Area – **ALL RIDERS AND MECHANICS TO ATTEND.**

**10.00am** Practice for each class; 5 minutes free going straight in to timed session. A **TIMING BOARD** will be shown.

Running order will be published in event programme. The class which each rider has qualified for will be published after timed practice.

**11.30** Racing commences. Three point scoring rides per class;

**7pm** for 7:30pm BXUK PARTY venue and tickets will be sent with acceptance.

#### Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> March;

**8.45am – 9.30am.** Documentation and transponder issuing for those riders who did NOT ride Saturday will be in race HQ near Sands Cafe.

**8.45am Technical Control** – for new riders or machines not present Saturday will take place in the competitor's car park.

**9.25am** ALL competitors to assemble at the gates of the competitors car park. **NO RIDING AROUND THE CAR PARKS.**

**9.40am** parade to work area AS PER Saturday

**9.50am** Riders briefing in the Work Area – **ALL RIDERS AND MECHANICS TO ATTEND**

**10am.** Practice for each class; 10 minutes timed session.

**11.00am** Racing commences. Three point scoring rides per class.

**30 MINUTES AFTER LAST RACE - PRESENTATION OF AWARDS.**

Times/schedules may be amended.

Ensure you observe final instructions sent with acceptance or displayed at event HQ.

#### 15. RESTRICTED ACCESS.

All circuit areas are for competitors who have entered and signed on for the event and signed on officials only. **Spectators view from the promenade only.**

**WARNING; No riding on the promenade or PUBLIC HIGHWAY.**

**16. DOGS;** Dogs are not permitted on the beach this includes the Work Area during the event and must be on lead at ALL times.

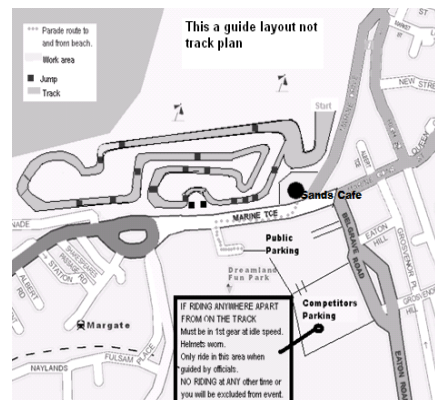
